

Fundraising Participation for Morden Minor Hockey

There are a few annual fundraisers / activities that all parents are asked to help with. These things help to pay for ice-time, ref and time-keeper costs, jersey replacements, keeping registration fees low, etc. Please see descriptions of these fundraisers / activities below.

Phonebook Deliveries

Morden Minor Hockey has the contract to deliver the provincial phonebooks in November and the regional phonebooks in August to the Morden and Winkler areas. The kids and parents on a team meet and work together to deliver the phonebooks to a set area. This happens in November and in August. It usually takes a couple of hours. Morden Minor Hockey is paid for each book delivered.

Co-Op Certificate Fundraiser

All parents are asked to buy or sell a minimum of \$125 Co-Op certificates in November and \$125 in February. There is no cost to parents but Morden Minor Hockey makes a 10% profit. The cash is simply traded in for certificates so; again, there is no out of pocket cost to parents for this fundraiser. Certificates can be spent on grocery items or gas in Morden or Winkler.

Hockey Day In Canada

A fun day is held every spring. Parents are asked to volunteer to run stations, help with organizing, etc. Parent participation is necessary to ensure this event runs smoothly and the kids always have a great day of activities and fun.
